Covid-19 (coronavirus)

Current government advice (at the time of writing) is for those with increased risk of severe illness from Covid-19 should stay at home. These include (though are not limited to):

- Aged 70 or older
- Under 70 with underlying health condition such as asthma, COPD, Bronchitis (ie anyone who is instructed to get a flu jab each year on medical grounds)
- Have chronic heart disease or kidney disease
- Have neurological condition such as Parkinson's dis ease, Motor Nuerone Disease or Multiple sclerosis
- Diabetes
- A weakened immune system as the result of medicines such as steroids or chemotherapy
- Those who are pregnant
