#### How we do it

By engaging, whenever possible, in an open dialogue with residents, to understand their needs and to explain how the Council will address these needs within the resources and powers available.

### Who we do it for

The people who live in the village and those who have a sustained investment in the success of the community.

## Objectives

Utilise the resources and assets available to the parish council;

• To ensure that the village remains clean, healthy and safe and that all residents are well informed.

• To identify the need and where required support the proposal and creation of a space(s) in the village where residents of all ages can come together to participate in sports, social, wellbeing and other leisure activities as well as access the services of the parish council.

• To protect the unique rural and historic nature of the village whilst recognising the future housing, education and infrastructure needs of the residents in the future.
