Hardingstone Parish Council has at last acquired possession of the lovely field we call Cherry Orchard Park for the benefit of the village.

That means it belongs to **all Hardingstone residents**. We would like your ideas as to what should happen to it, if anything.

If you're not sure how to access Cherry Orchard there are three entrances


- From Delapre woods on the footbridge over the A45,
- Via the footpath from High St. adjacent to the thatched cottages,
- Through the gate on Hardingstone lane where there is also access with a Radar key.

When the land was transferred to Hardingstone PC from West Northants Council, certain conditions on its use were agreed.

## What we can and can't do

- It must only be used as a public open space for recreational use.
- There is a public footpath that runs across the centre of the area.
- We cannot dispose of the land (not that we want to).
- We are restricted from doing anything on the land which may become a nuisance or disturbance to the land.
- No permanent building is allowed on the land.
