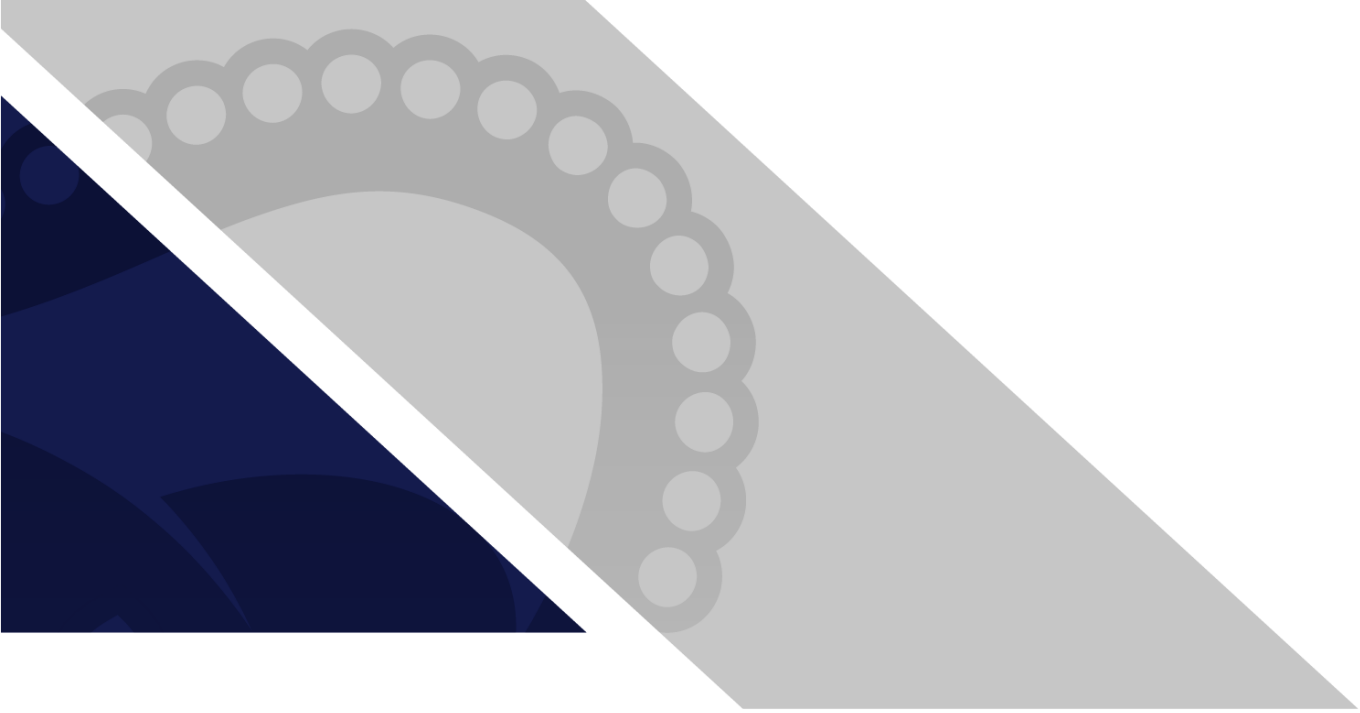

Parking – Bouverie Road/Martins Lane

We have received complaints of vehicles parking on the yellow lines at the junction of Bouverie Road & Martins Lane. The Road Traffic Act 1991 permitted local authorities legal powers to take over the enforcement of parking from the police, so since 2007 the council have been responsible for enforcing TRO's (i.e. single/double yellow lines). So we (police) cant issue to tickets for vehicles parked on single or yellow lines, however we can deal with vehicle if they are causing an obstruction. The council have been contacted and made aware of the parking concerns and asked to complete patrols to enforce the yellow lines in the area.

The Northamptonshire Safer Roads Alliance (NSRA) currently have a scheme in which they are loaning equipment/banners to schools which help prevent bad parking. This equipment consists of school buddies and A frames which promote think before you park. I will liaise with the school and the NSRA in relation to this. If equipment/banners work, I can then look at seeking funding through our OPFCC to purchase the items, so they can be used permanently.
