### Tent in Cherry Tree Orchard

Following the reports of a tent being erected in Cherry Tree Orchard, several visits have taken place in order for me to identify the owner/person who may be living inside it. This would then enable me to signpost them to agencies who can support them and I could also make them aware of the Severe Weather Emergency Protocol (SWEP).

The tent has signs that it has been lived in, however on each visit no one has been present. There is nothing inside the tent to identify who the owner/person living inside it may be. The councils outreach team have been made aware and they have also updated me to state that they have visited, but also had no joy.

I will continue to monitor this.

### **Residential Burglary – Tate Grove**

Following the residential burglary in Tate Grove, I have visited the victims in order to provide advice and reassurance and have also completed targeted patrols in the area and completed crime enquires such as house to house and a CCTV trawl.

As a result, I have obtained information in relation to a suspicious white can that was seen in the area on the date of the offence. I am awaiting the CCTV footage of this van to be sent to me, so I can then look a utilising automatic number plate recognition (ANPR) to try and identify the details of the van, in case the van is of interest to us.


