Overview

33 crimes recorded/reported.

None of the above were serious acquisitive crimes (SAC: Burglary, Auto crime & Robbery).

Of the 33 crimes, 24 Suspects have been identified.

A total of 17 arrests were made in connection with these offences.

8 suspects charged for court.

1 suspect remanded in custody.

2 suspects received conditional cautions.

1 suspect received a community resolution disposal.

****The below breakdown doesn't include the details of domestic crime & sexual offences. The reason behind this is due to their sensitive nature – however the data is included in the above figures****

The above stats are subject to change, due to enquiries being ongoing for a number of offences, so for example this may lead to further arrests or suspects being charged.

March Crime (Breakdown)

Trafficking in controlled drugs – Small quantity of cannabis intercepted by border force that was destined for an address on the parish. NFA due to it being such a small amount. The cannabis has been seized and destroyed.

Attempt burglary of a business – Sketty Close. Unknown persons cut a hole in the side of the premises however no entry is gained.

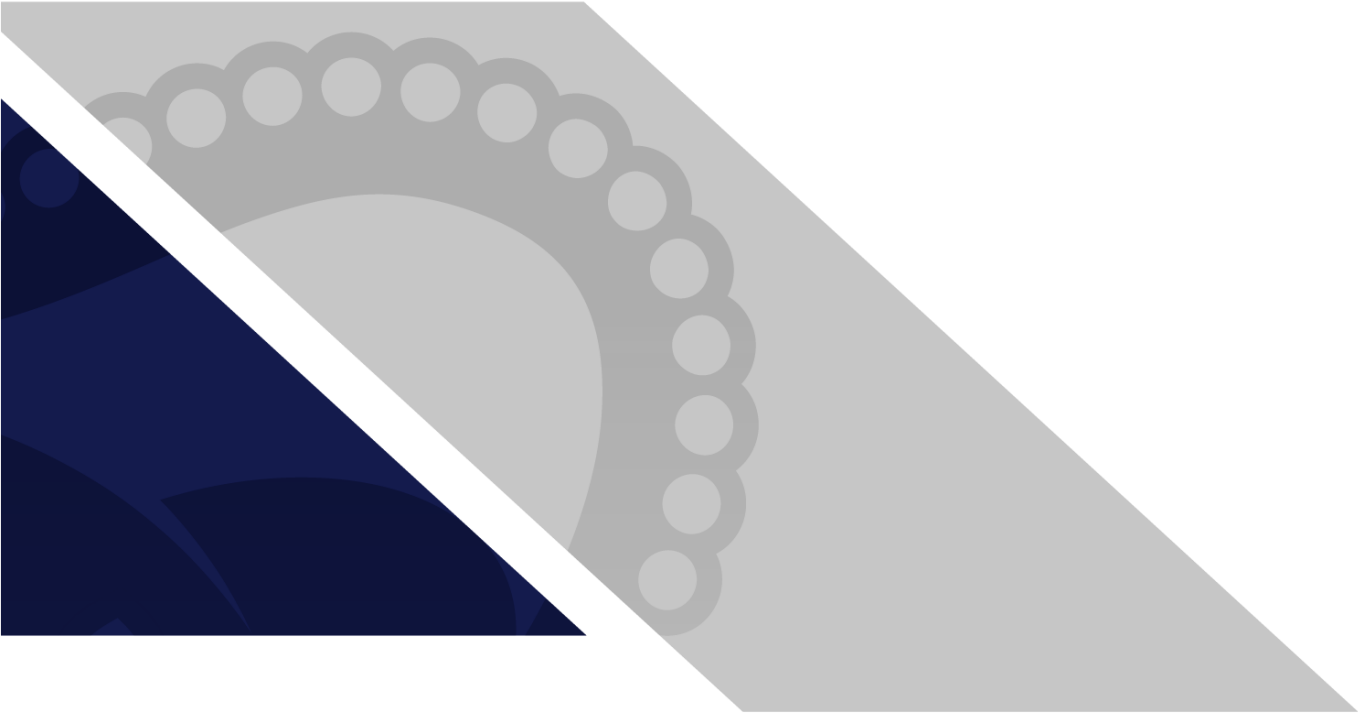
