Overview

23 crimes recorded/reported.

2 of the above crimes were serious acquisitive crimes (SAC: Burglary, Auto crime & Robbery).

Of the 23 crimes, 15 Suspects have been identified.

A total of 9 arrests were made in connection with these offences.

6 suspects charged for court.

****The below breakdown doesn't include the details of domestic crime & sexual offences. The reason behind this is due to their sensitive nature – however the data is included in the above figures****

****Offences committed at the Criminal Justice Centre are not included in the below breakdown, however are included in the stats above. The reason behind this is that offences committed at the CJC are unlikely to have a wider impact on residents in Hardingstone****

The above stats are subject to change, due to enquiries being ongoing for a number of offences, so for example this may lead to further arrests or suspects being charged.

May Crime (Breakdown)

Hardingstone Village

Arson not endangering life – Heritage Farm Close, investigation ongoing.

Assault with injury – Wild Cherry Crescent (off of Ladimore Road). Minor injury caused by dog, suspect identified, words of advice issued to owner.

Malicious communications – High St. Threats made to victim over the phone, suspect identified but NFA as victim withdrew support.

Robbery of personal property – Ongoing investigation, suspects identified.

Theft(other) – Bouverie Road. Theft of mobile phone

Assault without injury – Casswell Road. Victim pushed, suspect identified although NFA due to evidential difficulties.

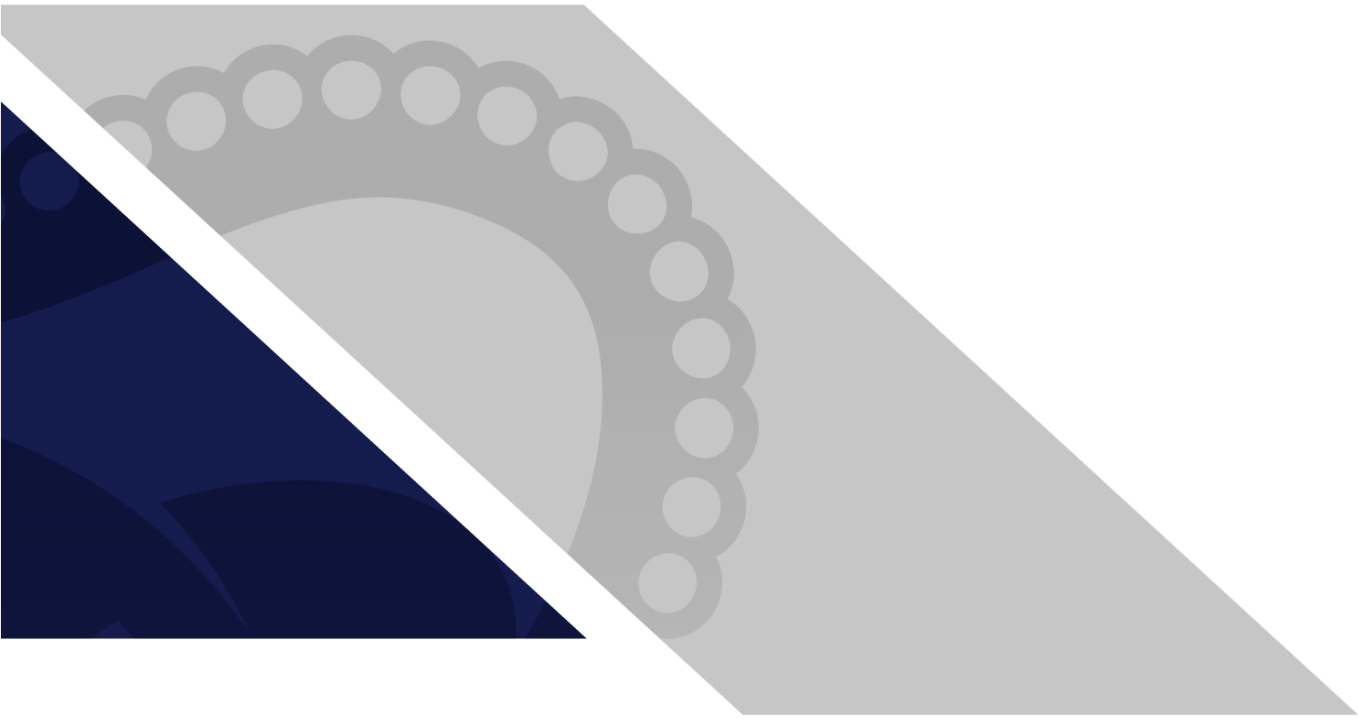
