Who we are

Homes England is the government's Housing and Regeneration Agency. We drive regeneration and housing delivery to create high quality homes and thriving places. For those of you who are joining us for the first time, Homes England is in the process of preparing an outline planning permission for Wymersley Green, which is an allocated site under Policy A3 The Green, Great Houghton in the adopted Northampton Local Plan Part 2.

What's happened?

Following the first stage of engagement and community feedback, in September 2023 we shared a draft Vision and Development Objectives on our online engagement platform. We then asked for your feedback on whether they accurately reflected your priorities and received positive feedback. The Vision and Development Objectives will serve as the guiding principles for a scheme on this site and will continue to evolve as the project progresses. Since then, we have been continuing to learn about the site through technical surveys and stakeholder feedback and collating the extensive and valuable community input from 2023.

A new name!

Over 250 people attended our drop-in sessions in July 2023 and we were delighted that so many of you shared your valuable local knowledge, thoughts and ideas for the site. One of the key pieces of feedback we received was that you would prefer a new site name, with a distinct identity and connection to the history of the local area. We carefully considered your feedback, and thanks to your suggestions are transitioning to **'Wymersley Green'**. There's more information about this on our online engagement platform.

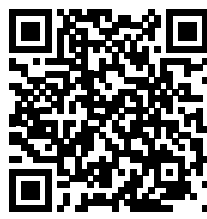
