

Hardingstone Parish September crime report

Date: 1st October 2024





Overview

27 crimes recorded/reported. Of the 27 crimes, 18 Suspects have been identified. A total of 12 arrests were made in connection with these offences.

2 suspects charged for court.

1 conditional caution issued.

1 community resolution disposal issued.

The below breakdown doesn't include the details of domestic crime & sexual offences. The reason behind this is due to their sensitive nature – however the data is included in the above figures

Offences committed at the Criminal Justice Centre are not included in the below breakdown, however are included in the stats above. The reason behind this is that offences committed at the CJC are unlikely to have a wider impact on residents in Hardingstone

The above stats are subject to change, due to enquiries being ongoing for a number of offences, so for example this may lead to further arrests or suspects being charged.

September Crime (Breakdown)

Hardingstone Village

Burglary of a home – Bay Willow Cres. Building under construction has been entered and boiler stolen from within, investigation ongoing.

Harassment – Suspect identified, community resolution disposal issued.

Malicious communications – Threats made to victim by unknown person.

Public fear, alarm or distress -Victim verbally abused, suspect identified although NFA due to evidential difficulties.

Theft(other) - Copper Beech Cres. Parcel stolen from doorstep,

Threat of crim damage – suspect identified & community resolution disposal issued. Trafficking in controlled drugs – Following intelligence received from the community, a misuse of drugs act warrant was executed at an address in the village, cannabis was found and also evidence of the supply of Class A. Suspect identified/arrested & released under investigation, investigation ongoing. A dog at the premise was also seized as it is believed to

be an unregistered XL bully. **Trafficking in controlled drugs** – Suspect has been identified through intel led enquiries to be allegedly involved in the supply of class A. Suspect arrested & released under investigation, investigation ongoing.

Trafficking in controlled drugs – Border force intercepted a parcel that was on route to an address in the parish that contained a small amount of cannabis. Cannabis seized & destroyed.

 Theft by an employee – Gowerton Rd. Suspect identified, investigation ongoing.


