Overview

38 crimes recorded/reported.

Of the 38 crimes, 33 Suspects have been identified.

A total of 20 arrests were made in connection with these offences.

11 suspects charged for court.

1 conditional caution issued.

1 community resolution disposal issued.

****The below breakdown doesn't include the details of domestic crime & sexual offences. The reason behind this is due to their sensitive nature – however the data is included in the above figures****

****Offences committed at the Criminal Justice Centre are not included in the below breakdown, however are included in the stats above. The reason behind this is that offences committed at the CJC are unlikely to have a wider impact on residents in Hardington****

The above stats are subject to change, due to enquiries being ongoing for a number of offences, so for example this may lead to further arrests or suspects being charged.

October Crime (Breakdown)

Hardington Village

Assault with injury – Victim struck in face, investigation ongoing.

Assault without injury – Victim grabbed, suspect identified, investigation ongoing.

Assault without injury – Victim pushed, suspect identified, NFA due to evidential difficulties.

Burglary - business/community – St Edmunds church. Window grill removed & stained glass smashed in an attempt to gain entry, investigation ongoing.

Possession cont drugs cannabis – suspect identified/arrested.

Possession of articles with blade or point – possession of scalpel, suspect identified/arrested & charged for court.

Public fear, alarm or distress – Victim verbally abused, suspect identified, words of advice given.

Public fear, alarm or distress – Victim verbally abused, suspect identified, NFA as victim withdraws support.

Racially or religiously aggravated harassment – Suspect identified, NFA due to evidential difficulties.

Racially or religiously aggravated harassment - Suspect identified, NFA as victim withdraws support.

Theft of motor vehicle – Falcon way. Vehicle stolen by unknown means but received short distance away.

Theft of motor vehicle – Gardeners view. Vehicle stolen by unknown means.

Trafficking in controlled drugs – Parcel intercepted by border force that contained a small amount of cannabis and was on route to an address in the parish. Cannabis seized/destroyed.

Brackmills industrial estate

Assault without injury – Liliput Rd. Victim has hair pulled. NFA as victim withdraws support.

Assault without injury – Osyth Close. Victim pushed, suspect identified, investigation ongoing.

Possession of articles with blade or point – Liliput Rd. Possession of blade, suspect identified/arrested & charged for court.

Handling stolen goods – Caswell Rd. Two suspects identified/arrested & charged.

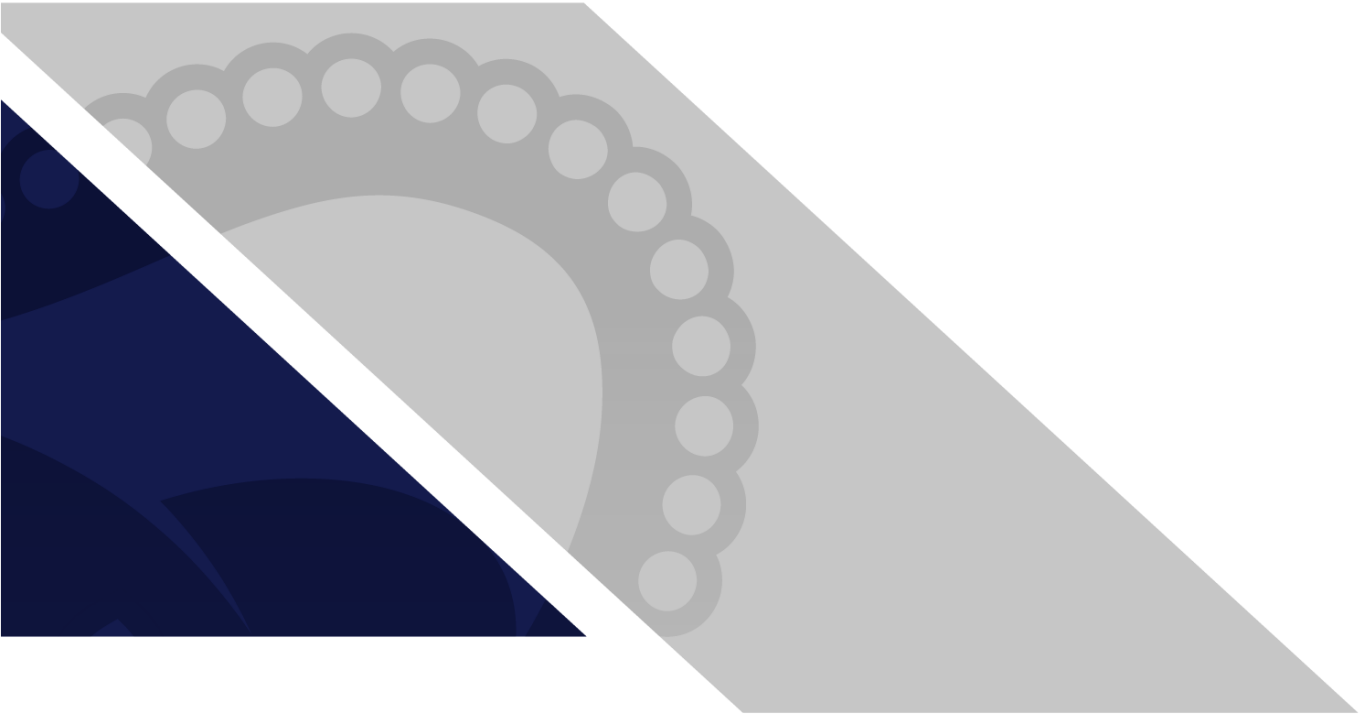
